### Budgewoi Holiday Park boasts an abundance of native flora and fauna

The holiday park faces the serene Lake Munmorah, with the calm waters housing a wealth of sea life. The lake is home to a range of aquatic life including flathead, bream, garfish, whiting and blackfish, and is also home to protected species including [Pipefish](#) and the [White's Seahorse](#).

Budgewoi Holiday Park is also a bird watchers paradise, so bring your binoculars for your chance to see Black Swans, Pelicans, White Breasted Sea Eagles, Honeyeaters and much more! Then, as the sun sets the ring-tailed possums and sugar gliders come out to play!

For the active nature lovers there are a range of long and short walks in the nearby Munmorah State Conservation Area including The Palms walking track and Wybung Trig Lookout which boasts stunning views of the park.
