Gumnut Award Program

The Gumnut Awards are a major initiative of the Caravan & Camping Industry Association of NSW. The Gumnut Awards recognise demonstrated commitment to sustainable environmental and socially responsible management.



The four Central Coast Holiday Parks have proudly achieved the Bronze Gumnut, with Toowoan Bay, Norah Head and Canton Beach Holiday Parks have also achieved the Silver Gumnut.

Please see the Gumnut award levels and the actions taken by the park managers for their achievements so far!

Bronze: For a park or business to achieve a Bronze Gumnut Award, their business must satisfy benchmark criteria from each of the 10 categories listed below. This self-assessment is audited by UWS experts.

Silver: To achieve a Silver Gumnut Award, park management must develop an integrated Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and satisfy an additional 20 criteria (over the 10 categories).

Gold: Attainment of Gold relies on significant progress and monitored outcomes from the EMP, as well as the development of a further 30 criteria. The UWS team carries out a site inspection before Gold is awarded.

The park managers need your help to sustain the environment. Some of the initiatives include energy saving, water conservation, waste management and conserving the natural environment.
